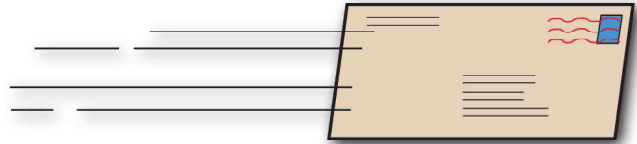

## SHOW-ME-SELECT HEIFER SALE RESULTS

### 282 Head Sold

A full house was on hand on a warm Saturday afternoon. Demand was good with the sale averaging \$2394.00 per head on 93 Lots. This was \$814.00 per head below last year's record average, but still \$217.00 per head higher than two years ago. Eleven Lots, totaling 40 heifers, from four reputation consignors, sold for \$3000.00 or more, with the top registered heifer selling for \$3700.00.

**REPLACEMENT HEIFERS:**

Large 1-2 1200-1400# mostly 3rd stage preg including several reputation registered heifers \$2600.00-\$3300.00 per head, couple packages registered heifers \$3450.00-\$3700.00 per head.

Medium & Large 1-2 1050-1250# 2nd & 3rd stage preg \$2250.00-\$2600.00 per head; 1000-1100# 2nd & 3rd stage preg \$1900.00-\$2250.00 per head.

Medium 1-2 850-1000# 2nd & 3rd stage preg \$1600.00-\$1850.00 per head.
