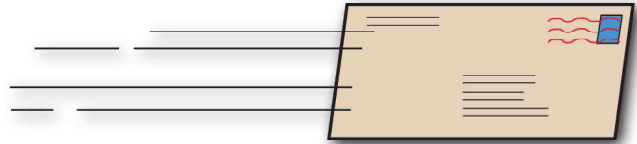

When looking back to the last tested feeder market from nearly a month ago the steers traded \$10.00-\$20.00 higher with the heifers steady to \$5.00 higher. While most auction barns were shut down for the holidays, the beef future markets finally found some footing & traded sharply higher, which has helped the cash market to start 2016 with stronger prices. The boxed beef trade has also exploded higher in the last week or so with the Choice cutout on Monday's close quoted up another 5.47 at 218.06. The choice carcass has added over 20.00 in the last six marketing days.
